CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

Salt River Pima-Maricopa Indian Community McDowell Road Closure Due To Construction

On June 30th, SRPMIC ECS Compliance recommended McDowell Road be closed to outside traffic from Gilbert Road to Mesa Drive due to safety concerns while under Construction.

Community Members are still allowed to use the road, for traveling to and from local residential locations along McDowell Road. Please observe the narrowed shoulders, safety barricades, and signage. Drive slowly (20 – miles per hour or less) and be sure that equipment operators see you as you pass by.

Access to the roadway will be open at Horne, Stapely, Harris, and Daley, with soft closure signage (local traffic only). At least one travel lane will be open at all times for emergency vehicles, busses, postal carrier, refuse trucks, and Community services. Some mail boxes will be temporarily relocated to the north side of McDowell Road, with access for the mail carrier during the Construction process.

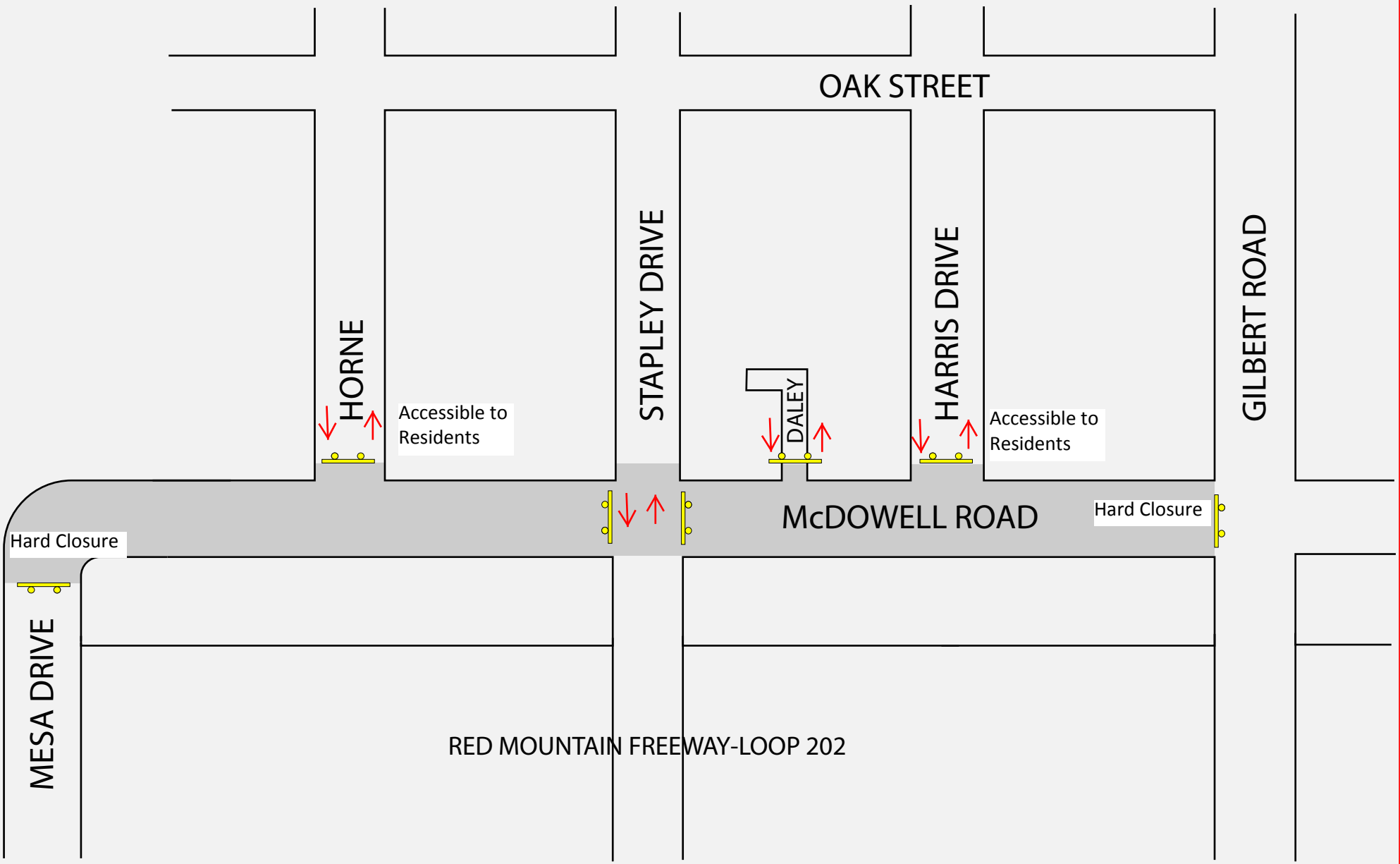
The hard closure will remain in effect for approximately 6-8 weeks. Segments of road will be opened up as they are completed with utilities and roadway paving.

The Contractors will be installing the waterline between Stapely and Mesa Drive the first and second week of July. ECS, Public Works, and their representatives may be stopping by your residence to confirm the location and placement of the new water service line and connection to your meter. The switch over from City of Mesa Water to Community water will occur sometime in mid-July.

We apologize for the inconvenience and disorderly appearance, but with the full closure, the Contractor will be able to work faster, and complete the job sooner.
