



# NOTICE OF 2012 SPECIAL ELECTION

## District I (Salt River)

### Thursday, January 26, 2012

Polls Open: 6:00am – 6:00pm



Council Member Anthony Collins, Sr. has resigned his position on the Salt River Pima-Maricopa Indian Community (“Community”) Council as a representative of District I (Salt River). Pursuant to Article X of the Community’s Constitution, a special election must be held within 30 days of a vacancy of office. Whomever is elected to fill this vacancy shall complete the remainder of Council Member Collins’ term of office which expires in December 2014.

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The SRPMIC Tribal Enrollment listing will be the registered voters’ list for all elections. An eligible voter must be an enrolled member of the Community, 18 years or older on the day of the election, and a resident of Salt River District (District I) for at least one (1) year. Pursuant to Article VI, Section 4 of the Community’s Constitution, persons who are a prisoner in any jail or in prison on the date of the election or who have been declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be incompetent are not eligible to vote in this election.

**POLLING SITE.** District I (Salt River) voters are to vote at SALT RIVER COMMUNITY BUILDING. (Polls open from 6am-6pm).

**COMMUNITY IDENTIFICATION OR APPROPRIATE EVIDENCE OF IDENTITY IS REQUIRED.**

Community members are not be required to register to vote. However, Community members must show a (picture) tribal ID card or appropriate evidence of identity at the polls before they will be given a ballot. Should you need a Tribal ID, contact the Office of Membership Services at (480) 362-7618. Since the tribal enrollment listing will be used to determine candidate and voter eligibility, please make sure that information such as your name, tribal ID number, and address are up-to-date with the Office of Membership Services.

**DEADLINE FOR NON-RESIDENT VOTERS (ABSENTEE BALLOT).**

**WHAT DISTRICT DO I VOTE IN?**

Members who live West of North Mesa Drive are considered to be a District I (Salt River) voter and should vote at Salt River Community Building. Members who live East of Mesa Drive are considered to be a District II (Lehi) and cannot vote in this special election.
