ABOUT THE CARING 4 SALT RIVER AWARD

Traditionally, our culture teaches that each person brings unique talents to our Community. The **Caring 4 Salt River** Award was created to recognize those talents and honor those individuals who are doing extraordinary things for the Salt River Pima-Maricopa Indian Community (SRPMIC).

Youth Award – awarded to a SRPMIC enrolled youth aged 12 to 17 years who best demonstrates their desire to make the Salt River Pima-Maricopa Indian Community a better place through community service, leadership in school, afterschool, clubs, cultural activities.

Community Member Award – awarded to a SRPMIC enrolled member aged 18 to 54 years who has demonstrated their desire to make the Salt River Pima-Maricopa Indian Community a better place through community service, leadership in their business, profession, self, volunteerism, cultural activities.

Elder Award – awarded to a SRPMIC enrolled member aged 55 and up who has demonstrated their desire to make the Salt River Pima-Maricopa Indian Community a better place through community service, leadership in their business, profession, self, volunteerism, cultural activities.

Friend of the Community Award – awarded to a non-community member who has devoted his or her energy and time to assist and improve the quality of life for the Salt River Pima-Maricopa Indian Community through his or her efforts that go beyond the responsibilities of his or her job.

Nomination/Submission Process

- Must be an enrolled SPRMIC member, 16 years and older to submit a nomination application.
- Only one nomination will be accepted per nominee.
- All nominations must be submitted in a sealed envelope.
- One fully completed application must be received by **Wednesday, June 6, 2012, 5pm.** Hand delivered or mailed.

- All submitted sealed envelopes must be date and time stamped by Community Relations.

- Awardees will be announced by Monday, June 11, 2012. Only winners and their nominators will be notified.
