NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Pursuant to Chapter 17, Section 17-5(d) of the Salt River Pima-Maricopa Indian Community (SRPMIC) Code of Ordinances, the SRPMIC Council has scheduled a public hearing for the project listed below. You may or may not be a landowner in this particular project; however, we are providing this notification to 1) SRPMIC members, and 2) landowners with ownership interest in land located within a ½ mile radius of the project.

DESIGNATION OF LAND USE FOR THE PUBLIC SAFETY COMMUNICATIONS

TOWERS PROJECT: 1) Granite Reef Dam Site and 2) Shea/Beeline Site

The proposed use is to provide Public Safety radio and wireless communication.

1) Granite Reef Dam Site: being a portion of the Northwest Quarter (NW ¼) of Section 13, Township 2 North, Range 6 East of the Gila and Salt River Base and Meridian, Maricopa County, Arizona, with the primary purpose to provide Public Safety radio communications in the preserve area behind Red Mountain along the Salt and Verde Rivers. It will also provide 911 and wireless service for Community Members. Lattice tower will be 120 ft. tall with multiple dishes and antennas, with up to four shelters inside a 75' X 75' block fence. Total area=0.30 acres (13,068 sq. ft.).

2) Shea/Beeline (SR 87) Site: being a portion of the Northeast Quarter (NE ¼) of Section 35, Township 3 North, Range 6 East of the Gila and Salt River Base and Meridian, Maricopa County, Arizona, with the primary purpose to provide Public Safety radio communications along the Beeline Highway (State Route 87) from Fountain Hills to Gilbert Road and in the preserve. Lattice tower will be 40 ft. tall with microwave dishes and antennas, and one 12' X 17' shelter. Total area= 0.04 acres (1,641 sq. ft.).
