

MUL-CHU-THA FAIR AND RODEO GUEST POLICIES

For the safety and enjoyment of all guests of the Mul-Chu-Tha Fair and Rodeo, please observe the following fair and rodeo policies:

- No outside beverages are allowed within the Mul-Chu-Tha fairgrounds site. For safety reasons glass bottles are prohibited within the fairground site.
- Mul-Chu-Tha Fair and Rodeo prohibits smoking inside any structure, dining area or entertainment area on the fair grounds.
- Unauthorized solicitation or distribution of fliers is not allowed on the fairground site.
- Vendors who are not contracted with the Mul-Chu-Tha Fair and Rodeo are NOT allowed to sell or distribute merchandise or materials within 350 feet of the Mul-Chu-Tha fairground site.
- Be kind to your pets – guests are encouraged to leave them at home when visiting the Mul-Chu-Tha Fair and Rodeo. Pets are highly discouraged for the safety of the pet due to the large number of people.
- The Mul-Chu-Tha Fair and Rodeo reserves the right to decline admittance to anyone who violates the reasonable policies established for public safety or to restrict activities such as public address to designated areas.
- All packages are subject to search.
- Weapons of any kind are not allowed on the Mul-Chu-Tha Fair and Rodeo site.
