

60-day ramp closure starts Monday, July 13 at the Loop 101 (Pima Freeway) Indian Bend Road interchange

RAMPS CLOSED FOR RECONSTRUCTION TO FIT WIDER FREEWAY

As part of the Loop 101 Improvement Project in the East Valley, on- and off-ramps will be closed for approximately two months starting Monday (July 13), according to the Arizona Department of Transportation.

The Loop 101 on- and off-ramps at Indian Bend Road are scheduled to close by early Monday morning. Crews will reconstruct the ramps so they fit into the path of the wider freeway. The ramps are due to reopen by mid-September.

For access to Talking Stick Resort, the Pavilions at Talking Stick and Talking Stick Golf Club, drivers are encouraged to use ramps at other nearby interchanges along Loop 101, including Via De Ventura or McDonald Drive, while the ramps at Indian Bend Road are closed.
