



## 60-day ramp closure start Monday, Sept. 14, 2015 at the Loop 101 (Pima Freeway) Chaparral Road interchange


RAMPS CLOSED FOR RECONSTRUCTION TO FIT WIDER FREEWAY

**As part of the Loop 101 Improvement Project in the East Valley, Chaparral Road on- and off-ramps will be closed for approximately two months starting Monday, Sept. 14, 2015, according to the Arizona Department of Transportation.**

The Loop 101 on- and off-ramps at Chaparral Road are scheduled to close by early Monday morning. Crews will reconstruct the ramps so they fit into the path of the wider freeway. The ramps are due to reopen by mid-November.

For access to Scottsdale Community College, drivers are encouraged to use adjacent ramps with the following suggested routes to campus:

- ▶ From northbound 101, exit at Indian School Road, head north on Pima Road, then proceed to Chaparral Road to campus, OR go east after exiting at Indian School Road, then head north on Dobson Road to Chaparral Road to campus.
- ▶ From southbound 101, exit at McDonald Drive, head south on Pima Road then proceed to Chaparral Road to campus.
