Some examples of contaminated sites (potential brownfield sites) could be; abandoned gas stations, abandoned dump sites with hazardous chemicals or petroleum products, old facilities with abandoned drums or known to have had spills of chemicals, buildings built prior to the 80's which may have building material such as asbestos or lead-based paint, PCB bearing ballasts, fluorescent light bulbs, and/or areas treated with pesticides that are now banned, etc.
