Primary Job Function:

Perform operating, cleanup, and inspection duties to ensure that all aspects of solid fuel uploading and stacking are done in a safe and efficient manner. Operate mobile equipment.

Essential Requirements:

- Able to wear all required safety equipment including but not limited to hardhats, safety glasses, safety harness, ear plugs, dust masks, and gloves
- Lift up to 100 pounds of weight properly
- Perform repetitious arm, hand, and leg motion
- Ascend and descend stairs and ladders
- Ability to do bending, kneeling, twisting, in confined spaces and awkward positions for extended periods of time
- Capable of climbing up and down, above, inside, and under equipment
- Ability to handle heights up to 460 feet

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

- Able to read, write and communicate clearly for log keeping and completing the equipment pre-check sheet
- Maintain valid driver's license
- Operate mobile equipment such as fork truck, dump truck, guzzler, sweeper, skid loader – ½ yard, and water truck to unload and move material and perform clean up
- Operate railcar moving equipment
- Operate railcar unloading and bin filling systems such as coal, coke, clinker, gypsum, and other commodities included in the production process
- Ability to cross train

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Know and follow all company safety procedures and policies
- Check condition of mobile equipment before operating, including tire inflation, brakes, oil, air pressure, and add fuel, oil and water as needed
- Report any malfunctions immediately to supervisor
- Complete equipment pre-check sheet for each piece of equipment prior to operation
- Log all railcar numbers, dates, condition, etc. as required
- Gather samples from each railcar or truck for testing by the laboratory
- Perform cleanup duties such as cleaning feed chutes, transfer points, belts, pulleys, etc.
