Dear Golfers,

In February 2003, we established a charitable Foundation to benefit our children and youth. This nonprofit Foundation, the Salt River Community Children's Foundation (SRCCF), ensures that funding is always available to provide services "for the kids." The SRCCF has an annual applications cycle and makes awards each spring, while giving smaller proposals consideration throughout the year. To raise funds for these awards, the SRCCF will be hosting its 11<sup>th</sup> Annual Golf Classic on Monday, December 1, 2014, and invites you to participate.

The Golf Classic will be hosted by the Talking Stick Golf Club (9998 E Indian Bend Rd, Scottsdale, AZ 85256) which is located one mile east of the Loop 101 (Pima Freeway) on Indian Bend Rd. In conjunction, the Talking Stick Resort will have rooms available for you at the rate of \$109/night for Sunday, November 30<sup>th</sup> and Monday, December 1<sup>st</sup>. To make your reservations, call (480) 270.5555 and cite the Booking ID #7275, or request the "11<sup>th</sup> Annual SRCCF Golf Classic" group rate up to the day prior to the tournament.

The Classic will be a scramble format and will begin with a shotgun start at 10:00 am. Fees are \$1600 per foursome or \$400 per individual golfer. All golfers will receive golf, a gift bag, apparel, box lunch, and refreshments. The SRCCF team will also be hosting an After-Golf Party following play with hors d'oeuvres and raffle prizes while awaiting the tally for the awards. Sponsorship opportunities may also be available, and if that is of interest to you or your company, feel free to contact the SRCCF team for additional information.

The SRCCF team will limit the Classic this year to 36 foursomes on the North Course and 36 on the South Course which will accelerate the speed of play. To participate, please fill out the enclosed registration forms and email or fax them back to the SRCCF with your choice of payment (check is preferred). If you have more than one foursome, you will need to complete one registration form per foursome, with pairings of your choice.

It is our goals to ensure that you have an especially enjoyable day on the golf course, and that we raise valuable funding for the children of the Salt River Pima-Maricopa Indian Community. We appreciate your support in helping us build a better future for the Community's children and youth. What better way to kick off the Holiday Season than with a golf tourney benefitting kids!
