Dear Golfers,

The Salt River Pima-Maricopa Indian Community (“Community”) has established a charitable Foundation to benefit its children and youth. This Foundation, the Salt River Community Children’s Foundation (“SRCCF”), ensures that funds will always be available to provide services for the kids. Those serving Community children can submit proposals for funding through an annual applications cycle. To raise funds for the kids, the SRCCF will be hosting its 8th Annual Charity Golf Classic on Monday, December 5, 2011, and invites you to participate.

The Golf Classic will take place at the Talking Stick Golf Club, 9998 E. Indian Bend Road, Scottsdale, AZ (just east of the 101 Freeway & Indian Bend exit). For our golfers, Casino Arizona’s beautiful Talking Stick Resort, a four-star hotel, has reserved a block of 20 rooms at the rate of \$119 per night for December 4th & 5th. Golfers wanting to reserve rooms should call (480) 270-5555 and request the “Children’s Foundation Golf Tournament” rate. However, the room block **will be lifted on Sunday, November 27, 2011.**

The Tournament will be a scramble format and begin with a shotgun start at 10:00 a.m. The cost will be the same as the previous two years: \$1,600 per foursome or \$400 per single golfer. For your contribution, you will receive: golf, gift bag, golf apparel, box lunch, awards, raffle prizes, plus an after-golf reception. There are also sponsorship packages available that may interest you or your company. Those sponsor opportunities are available on our webpage.

It is our dual goals to ensure that you have an especially enjoyable day while helping us raise funds. We are limiting the tourney to 56 foursomes: 28 on the North and 28 on the South Courses which will facilitate the speed of play. To participate, please fill out the registration forms and fax or email them back with your choice of payment. If you have more than one foursome, you will need to fill out one registration form per foursome, with pairings of your choice. This will also assist in the preparation of the golf carts and scorecards.

We appreciate your support in helping us build a better future for the Community’s children and youth. What better way to kick off the holidays than with a golf tournament benefiting the kids!
