Dear Golfers,

In February 2003, the Salt River Pima-Maricopa Indian Community (SRPMIC) established a nonprofit Foundation to benefit its children and youth. This charitable Foundation, the Salt River Community Children's Foundation (SRCCF), ensures that funding will always be available to provide services "for the kids." The SRCCF has an annual applications cycle and makes awards each spring, and also gives smaller proposals consideration throughout the year. To raise funds for these awards, the SRCCF will be hosting its 12th Annual Golf Classic on Monday, December 7, 2015, and the SRPMIC invites your participation.

The Golf Classic will be held on the SRPMIC at the Talking Stick Golf Club (9998 E Indian Bend Rd, Scottsdale, AZ 85256) which is located one mile east of the Loop 101 (Pima Freeway) on Indian Bend Rd. In support, the Talking Stick Resort will have rooms available for you at the modest rate of \$109/night for Sunday, December 6th and Monday, December 7st. To make your reservations, call (480) 270.5555 and cite the Booking ID # 9844, or request the "12th Annual SRCCF Golf Classic" group rate up to the day prior to the tournament.

Tourney play will begin with a shotgun start at 10:00 a.m. and will be of a scramble format. Fees are \$1600 per foursome or \$400 per individual golfer. All golfers will receive golf, a gift bag, apparel, box lunch, and refreshments. There will be also be an After-Golf Party following play with hors d'oeuvres and raffle prizes while awaiting the tally of the scorecards. Also, if it is of interest to you or your company, sponsorship opportunities may be available. Contact the SRCCF team for additional information.

The tourney will be limited to 36 foursomes on the North Course, and 36 on the South Course. To participate, please fill out the enclosed registration forms and email or fax them back to the SRCCF with your choice of payment (check is preferred). If you have more than one foursome, you will need to complete one registration form per foursome, with pairings of your choice.

It is our dual goals to ensure that all of you have an especially enjoyable day on the golf course, while at the same time helping our Foundation raise valuable funds. We appreciate your support in helping us secure a better future for the Community's children and youth. What better way to kick off the Holiday Season than with a golf tourney benefitting kids!
