

Piipaash Sewing Class: Men's Ribbon Shirt

presented by the O'odham Piipaash Language Program

Mondays & Wednesdays | June 1-29, 2016

6pm-8pm | CRD Main Classroom

Participants will be introduced to the Piipaash language used while making a men's traditional shirt.

Requirements:

- Open to Community member women with intermediate sewing experience.
- MUST have own sewing machine and sewing supplies.
- 16 & over (under 18 must be accompanied by an adult)
- MUST sign-up in person at the CRD office.
- Participants will be required to fill out a questionnaire and will be selected to participate in the class based on intermediate sewing experience.
- Class limit: 6 participants

OPLP will provide:

- Fabric and thread for shirt only
- Iron/Ironing board
- Extension cords/power strips
- Butcher paper and pencils.

Participants will provide:

- Ribbon/rick-rack for shirt (applique will not be taught in this class)
- Fabric to match ribbon or rick-rack
- Sewing machine
- Sewing supplies (specific list will be provided)
