CARP is a program designed to beautify and revitalize the Community through small and large scale cleanup projects. To date three large cleanup projects have been completed. CARP was created as a spinoff to the annual Earth Day celebration and in response to Community Member concerns with blighted areas and abandoned, burnt or partially burned structures. Programs such as CARP are initiated to promote environmental stewardship and to help reduce ecological hazards within the Community. CARP is administered through EPNR with support from various departments such as ECS, Public Works, EDD and MRPM and is free of charge to Community Members. If you have a small scale cleanup project or an abandoned or unsafe structure and would like assistance with the demolition and removal please call the EPNR Hotline to receive an application. EPNR will need to gain landowner/homeowner consent prior to conducting any cleanups.

Benefits to the Community:

- Helps keep Community Lands clean.
- Reduces gang-related activities.
- Provides short-term resources to interested Community home owners.
