### Purpose:

To modify fire responses to the Jail Facility in an effort to provide the safest environment for firefighters and Corrections Officers.

### Procedures:

1. All size up, tactical priorities, and allowances for water supply shall follow established Standard Operating Guidelines.
2. Once a size up has been made, the Incident Commander or first arriving officer shall meet with the Corrections Supervisor to get a report of conditions and actions being taken.
3. Once it is determined that the firefighters need to take action, all crews shall wear complete Personal Protective Equipment and take ONLY a hose line into the structure.
4. **NO TOOLS** shall be taken into the building during initial search and rescue/fire control. Once the inmates are secured in a safe location away from the fire operations, tools may be brought in to accomplish fire control and overhaul.
5. Any inmates that are injured from the fire or evacuation shall be administered to in a secured treatment area. Corrections Officers shall be in the treatment area during the medical assessment and treatment of inmates.
6. Any injured Corrections Officers or Police Officers shall be medically treated in a separate area from the injured inmates.
7. During all fire and medical operations, a Unified Command shall be established with Corrections and the Police Departments.
