ORDINANCE NUMBER: - SRO-468-2015

TO AMEND CHAPTER 17 OF THE SALT RIVER PIMA-MARICOPA INDIAN COMMUNITY CODE OF ORDINANCES, BY REPEALING ARTICLE VII, SEC. 17-274(1) AND SEC. 17-278; ARTICLE IX, SEC. 17-345(H)(3) AND (4); ARTICLE X, SEC. 17-375(A) IN ITS ENTIRETY AND ADOPTING A REVISED ARTICLE VII, SEC. 17-274(1) AND SEC. 17-278; ARTICLE IX, SEC. 17-345(H)(3) AND (4); AND ARTICLE X, SEC. 17-375(A) TO MAINTAIN CONSISTENCY IN THE ADMINISTRATION AND REGULATION OF ORDERLY AND COMPREHENSIVE LAND USE REQUIRED BY THE SALT RIVER PIMA-MARICOPA INDIAN COMMUNITY ZONING ORDINANCE.

BE IT ENACTED THAT:

Chapter 17, Article VII, Sec. 17-274(1) and Sec. 17-278; Article IX, Sec. 17-345(h)(3) and (4); and Article X, Sec. 17-375(a) of the Salt River Pima-Maricopa Indian Community Code of Ordinances, is hereby repealed in its entirety and a revised Chapter 17, Article VII, Sec. 17-274(1) and Sec. 17-278; Article IX, Sec. 17-345(h)(3) and (4); and Article X, Sec. 17-375(a) is hereby enacted, as follows:

CHAPTER 17. DEVELOPMENT, REAL PROPERTY, AND HOUSING

ARTICLE VII. OUTDOOR ADVERTISING SIGNS

Sec. 17-274. Additional outdoor advertising signs prohibited.

No permit shall be issued for the erection of any outdoor advertising signs except:

(1) As provided in section 17-275(2); or


Sec. 17-375. Generally.

- (a) *Article definitions.* All terms regarding the development of land appearing in this section shall be defined by reference to the definitions that appear in the Community's zoning ordinance.

This Ordinance is hereby enacted pursuant to the authority contained in Article VII, Section 1 of the Constitution of the Salt River Pima-Maricopa Indian Community ratified by the Tribe, February 28, 1990, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior, March 19, 1990, and amended by the Tribe, February 27, 1996, and approved by the Secretary April 23, 1996, the foregoing Ordinance was adopted this 1st day of July, 2015, in a duly called meeting held by the Community Council in Salt River, Arizona at which a quorum of 5 members were present by a vote of 4 for; 1 opposed, 0 abstentions, and 4 excused.
