ORDINANCE NUMBER: - SRO-469-2015

TO AMEND CHAPTER 18 OF THE SALT RIVER PIMA-MARICOPA INDIAN COMMUNITY CODE OF ORDINANCES, BY REPEALING ARTICLE I, SEC. 18-1(b) IN ITS ENTIRETY AND ADOPTING A REVISED ARTICLE I, SEC. 18-1(b) TO MAINTAIN CONSISTENCY IN THE ADMINISTRATION AND REGULATION OF ORDERLY AND COMPREHENSIVE LAND USE REQUIRED BY THE SALT RIVER PIMA-MARICOPA INDIAN COMMUNITY ZONING ORDINANCE.

BE IT ENACTED THAT:

Chapter 18, Article I, Sec. 18-1(b) of the Salt River Pima-Maricopa Indian Community Code of Ordinances, is hereby repealed in its entirety and a revised Chapter 18, Article I, Sec. 18-1(b) is hereby enacted, as follows:

CHAPTER 18. WATER AND OTHER NATURAL RESOURCES

ARTICLE I. IN GENERAL


Sec. 18-1. Conversion of wells from agricultural to domestic use.

- (a) *Restrictions on issuance of permits.* The building official shall not issue a building and construction permit pursuant to the zoning ordinance for the drilling or construction of a well to supply water for agricultural irrigation or for any other nondomestic use unless the plans and specifications indicate and the permit requires that the well be constructed in such a way that it can be readily converted to use supplying domestic water. Such wells shall have such protections against contamination as are required in wells constructed for domestic water supply.

C E R T I F I C A T I O N

This Ordinance is hereby enacted pursuant to the authority contained in Article VII, Section ___ of the Constitution of the Salt River Pima-Maricopa Indian Community ratified by the Tribe, February 28, 1990, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior, March 19, 1990, and amended by the Tribe, February 27, 1996, and approved by the Secretary April 23, 1996, the foregoing Ordinance was adopted this 1st day of July, 2015, in a duly called meeting held by the Community Council in Salt River, Arizona at which a quorum of 5 members were present by a vote of 4 for; 1 opposed, 0 abstentions, and 4 excused.
