

SRIC/SRPD Insurance Disqualifiers.

- 1.) Alcohol related violation such as D.U.I. or drug violation within past five years
- 2.) Reckless driving within the past five years.
- 3.) Three or more moving violations within the last three years
- 4.) Two or more speeding tickets in excess of 15 MPH over the posted speed limit within the last three years.
- 5.) More than two at fault accident within the past three years.
- 6.) Driver under the age of twenty-one (21)
- 7.) Drivers License suspended or revoked within three years.

SRPD/Arizona P.O.S.T. disqualifiers.

- 1.) Not have been convicted of a felony or any offense that would be a felony if committed in Arizona;
- 2.) Not have been dishonorably discharged from the United States Armed Forces;
- 3.) Not have been previously denied certified status, have certified status revoked, or have current certified status suspended;
- 4.) Not have illegally used sold, produced, cultivated, or transported marijuana for sale;
- 5.) Not have illegally used marijuana for any purpose within the past three years; unless
The use of marijuana exceeds a total of 20 times or exceeds five times since the age of 21 years;
Or
- 6.) Not have ever illegally used marijuana other than for experimentation: or
1. The use of marijuana exceeds a total of 20 times or exceeds five times since the age of 21 years;
Or
- 7.) Not have ever illegally used marijuana while employed or appointed as a peace officer;
- 8.) Not have illegally sold, produced, cultivated, or transported for sale any dangerous drug or narcotic, other than marijuana;
- 9.) Not have illegally used a dangerous drug or narcotic, other than marijuana for any purpose within the past seven years;
- 10.) Not have ever illegally used a dangerous drug or narcotic other than for experimentation;
- 11.) Not have ever illegally used a dangerous drug or narcotic while employed or appointed as a peace officer;
- 12.) Not have a pattern of abuse of prescription medication;
- 13.) Undergo a polygraph examination that meets the requirements of R13-4-106, unless prohibited by law;
- 14.) Not have been convicted of or adjudged to have violated traffic regulations governing the movement of vehicles with a frequency within the past three years that indicates a disrespect for the traffic laws or a disregard for the safety of other persons on the highway;

The Illegal use of marijuana, or a dangerous drug or narcotic is presumed to be not for experimentation if: The use of any dangerous drug or narcotic, other than marijuana, in any combination exceeds a total of five times, or exceeds one time sine the age of 21 years

Steroids-1989 made illegal-unless prescribed.
