Article VI Division 6 TRUCK ROUTES

Sec. 16-237. Certain Commercial Vehicles Prohibited on Non-Truck Routes

No person shall operate any commercial vehicle exceeding 10,000 pounds gross vehicles weight at any time upon any streets within the Community except those streets as adopted truck routes; except that the operator of a commercial vehicle may leave an adopted truck route by the nearest route to make a single delivery or pickup, after which he or she must return immediately by the nearest route to an adopted truck route.

The provisions of this section do not apply to passenger buses, any vehicle owned by a public utility while necessarily in use in the construction, installation or repair of any public utility, any authorized emergency vehicle, or any vehicle owned and operated by the Community.

Sec. 16-239 Variances

Any person seeking a variance may request such a variance in writing from the Director of Engineering and Construction Services (ECS). The ECS Director or his or her designee will respond to the request for variance within five business days of the receipt of the request. There shall be no appeal from the decision of the Director or his or her designee.

HAUL PERMITS

Construction and demolition haulers shall contact Engineering and Construction Services Department (ECS) Compliance Division for a haul permit and approval of proposed haul routes. Haul drivers must have the approved haul permit in possession. Failure to follow the approved route is subject to enforcement action.

Commercial vehicles exceeding 10,000 pounds may only travel on adopted truck routes except to make a delivery or pick up using the nearest route from the adopted truck routes.
