### 16-215 Calculation Table

1 mile over = \$50 base + \$5 = <b>\$55 fine</b>	11 miles over = \$50 base + \$55 = <b>\$105 fine</b>
2 miles over = \$50 base + \$10 = <b>\$60 fine</b>	12 miles over = \$50 base + \$60 = <b>\$110 fine</b>
3 miles over = \$50 base + \$15 = <b>\$65 fine</b>	13 miles over = \$50 base + \$65 = <b>\$115 fine</b>
4 miles over = \$50 base + \$20 = <b>\$70 fine</b>	14 miles over = \$50 base + \$70 = <b>\$120 fine</b>

8 miles over = \$50 base + \$40 = <b>\$90 fine</b>	18 miles over = \$50 base + \$90 = <b>\$140 fine</b>
9 miles over = \$50 base + \$45 = <b>\$95 fine</b>	19 miles over = \$50 base + \$95 = <b>\$145 fine</b>
10 miles over = \$50 base + \$50 = <b>\$100 fine</b>	20 miles over = \$50 base + \$100 = <b>\$150 fine</b>
