Mesa Public Schools is encouraging families who live in Mesa and need reliable internet to sign up with Cox Communications [Connect2Compete](#) program, which now includes two months of free internet for new customers who sign up by September 30, 2020. All Mesa addresses have been preloaded into Cox's system and families should be prequalified. In addition, the Cox program includes is:

- Free WiFi Modem

### **New Enrollment**

Mesa Public Schools is accepting new student enrollments for the 2020-21 school year. Families can enroll their child by going to [www.mpsaz.org/enroll](http://www.mpsaz.org/enroll). At the bottom of the webpage parents can click on the “I am a new parent” button and it will take them to an online registration account page. Parents will need to click Activate New Account and then click the Create a New Account button. Some important information to have on hand: you will need your [child's proof of age and identity](#), [proof of residence](#) and [immunization records](#). You will have the opportunity to upload these documents during the enrollment process.
