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Crisis Intervention Services

- 24/7/365 Crisis Intervention
- Responds to calls concerning suicidal ideation, substance use, depression, anxiety, psychosis, domestic violence, death notifications, and traumatic events
- Screening, assessment, and stabilization
- Crisis can be reached by calling (480) 850-9230



Domestic Violence Victim Advocacy

- Provides assistance with emergency shelter, obtaining orders of protection, and support during legal proceedings
- Individual and group counseling services



Behavioral Health Consultation

- Integrated model of care
- Screening, brief intervention, and referrals
- Pain management
- Smoking cessation

Psychological Testing/ Assessment

- Testing- administration of standardized or norm reference materials. Standardized tests are administered the same way, every single time. Patients are compared to peers of similar age, education and background
- Assessment- gathering of important information through interview, medical records, school records, observations, collateral information from families and care givers



How is Testing Useful

- Helps to further understand a person and their behavior
- Helps identify strengths and weaknesses
- Measures an individual's performance right now
- Can be helpful for differential diagnosis or ruling out a diagnosis
- Can help to clarify a diagnosis
- Can assist with treatment planning and recommendations for therapeutic modalities



What BHS Can Provide

General Psychological Testing

- Determine IQ
- Basic achievement functions
- Personality

Neuropsychological Testing

- Determine current cognitive functions
- Cognitive changes associated with a neurological condition



When Should A Referral Be Considered

Concerns about cognitive ability

Memory

Attention

Interferes with school or work

Concerns about behavior

Ability to problem solve or reason through situations

Interfering with work, relationships, school, etc.

Possible undiagnosed learning disability with adults or to get updated documentation



When Should A Referral Be Considered

- Known neurological condition (stroke, TBI, concussion, dementia)
- Differential diagnosis (anxiety vs ADHD)

Psychiatrist Role

- Psychiatry is the branch of medicine that focuses on the prevention, diagnosis, and treatment of mental, behavioral, and emotional disorders. A psychiatrist is a medical doctor who specializes in the mental health field
- Psychiatrist provides comprehensive assessment of medical, neurological and behavioral functioning and needs of the patient
- When appropriate, prescribes medication to treat depression, anxiety, mood dysregulation, ADHD and psychosis
- Supportive counseling and psychotherapy



Psychiatrist Role

- Provide psychiatric support at DOC
- Main role in determining mental state, capacity and risk for those under Emergency Apprehension
- Assist the Salt River Court regarding guardianship and capacity issues
- Collaborative role with BHS psychologist, case managers and counselors
