ASAM's criteria uses six dimensions to create a holistic, biopsychosocial assessment of an individual to be used for service planning and treatment across all services and levels of care. The six dimensions are:

# ASAM Dimension 6- Recovery Environment Challenges/Barriers

- Boredom and Isolation
- Uncomfortable Emotions
- Reentry Issues from DOC
- License, SSN, Warrants prevent employment
- Lack of support from Sober Family and Safe Environment to return to

- Navigators/Peers to help with social navigation (IDs, SSN, Apps, Resources
