Community, in which an enrolled member of the Community owns at least 51% of the
financial interest in the company. If the company is owned by more than one enrolled
member of the Community, the combined ownership interest must be at least 51%.
Additionally, at least one of the enrolled member owners must be able to demonstrate
active participation in the daily operations, and decision making of the company, and
entitlement to at least 51% of the company profits, as evidenced by company documents.

Native American-owned Businesses must meet the definition provided in Policy 3-5:

• A properly licensed business established or organized to conduct business on the Community, in which a Native American owns at least 51% of the financial interest in the company. If the company is owned by more than one Native American, the combined ownership interest must be at least 51%. Additionally, at least one of the Native American owners must be able to demonstrate active participation in the daily operations and decision making of the company, and entitlement to at least 51% of the company profits, as evidenced by company documents.
