

**NOTICE OF LAND MANAGEMENT BOARD (LMB) COMMUNITY HEARING
CULTURAL RESOURCE DEPARTMENT (CRD) CULTURAL CAMPUS
Case No. 24-LUR-03**

The Salt River Pima-Maricopa Indian Community (SRPMIC) Cultural Resources Department and Public Works are seeking a Designation of Land Use (DOLU) for the SRPMIC Cultural Campus. This land use review is for the Cultural Resource Department (CRD) Cultural Campus, an area that currently contains the Community's cultural repository, SRP-MIC Tribal Historic Preservation Office (TPHO), Community Garden and SRP-MIC Day School (under reconstruction). With the requested DOLU, other vacant land within the CRD Cultural Campus may be developed with future additional cultural uses or as a mix of government, civic and community services as allowed within the Administrative Public (AP) zoning district. The Cultural Campus is located on tribal land and is currently situated at the northeast corner of McDowell Road and Longmore. The total site is 18.648 acres.
